* All students are required to complete either a six-hour history or literature sequence. Students must also complete three hours in the area outside their sequence. (e.g. a student completing HY 101 and 102 must take a Literature course to satisfy degree requirements). Twelve hours in Humanities (HU) are required to graduate. If a student elects to complete two history courses, s/he must complete at least one additional HU course to fulfill UA core requirement.

** In order to graduate from UA, you must have one year of a Foreign Language or one year of Computer Science. CIS203 from WCC + NUR319 from UA will meet the computer requirement.

***Students may opt to take an NLN challenge exam at WCC to receive credit for NHM 101, Intro to Human Nutrition.
