Upward Bound Summer Students Create Vision Boards

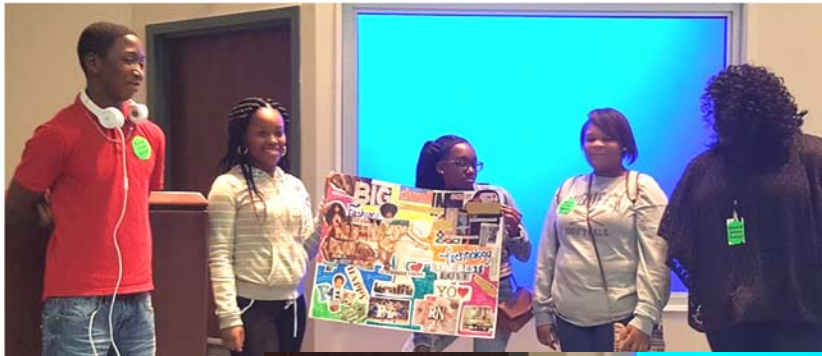


During Upward Bound’s Summer Component, the students created vision boards. These vision boards reflect a visual representation of their dreams for the future.
