Scholarships and Financial Aid Information

American Society of Civil Engineers-Dothan Branch-Caleb Kearly Memorial 2018 Scholarship. Qualifying students must reside in Barbour, Coffee, Dale, Geneva, Henry, Houston, or Pike counties. Scholarship amount(s) will range from \$1000 to \$2500 depending on funds available. Application deadline is May 15, 2018.

2018 Brookwood Medical Auxiliary, Inc. Scholarship. The members of Brookwood Medical Auxiliary, Inc. will be awarding several scholarships in medically related fields for the school year 2018-2019. The deadline for receipt of the applications and all accompanying documents is May 24, 2018. Applicants will be informed of scholarship decisions in July.
