



# Wallace Community College Learning Resources Centers System

The Learning Resources Centers System provides a current collection of resources and services to faculty, staff, and students to support college and lifelong learning. The LRC collection includes approximately 45,000 print format books, 50,000 e-books, 170 print periodical titles, and 1,300 audiovisual resources. In addition, approximately 100 online electronic databases are available to Wallace Community College students. These databases include the *Alabama Virtual Library*.

Resources and services are provided at all sites. All students are encouraged to use the LRC resources and services to enhance their learning and research opportunities.



## **Services and Programs Available**

### ***Computers and Information Technologies***

- Available for use by faculty, staff, and students
- First come, first-served basis
- Print cards necessary for computer printing (\$5.50 for 100 single side pages) are available at both LRC locations

### ***Circulating Books***

- Available for check-out for up to four weeks by students
- Renewable if not placed on hold by another student
- Limit of four books per student

### ***Electronic Databases***

- *Online Library Catalog*
- *Alabama Virtual Library* (periodical multi-database)
- *NetLibrary* (e-books)
- *ProQuest Nursing and Allied Health Source*
- *JSTOR*



## Services and Programs Available (continued)

### ***Interlibrary Loan (ILL)***

- Offers opportunity to borrow books from local libraries through written cooperative agreements

### ***LRC Orientation***

- Offers research skills instruction for classes and individuals upon request

### ***Media Software***

- Available for overnight check-out with a refundable \$5.00 deposit per item
- Limit of two items per patron
- Limited check-out requirements on some items

### ***NetLibrary***

- Provides access to over 50,000 electronic books (e-books) through the NetLibrary database
- Offers access from off-campus locations after patron has created an account using one of the College computers
- Is accessible from the WCC-LRC home page



## Services and Programs Available (continued)

### ***Periodicals***

- Print periodicals available for in-house use
- Listing of current print periodicals and back issues available at each location and on the LRC home page

### ***Alabama Virtual Library***

- More than 10,000 periodicals available online (with approximately two-thirds of these articles in full-text format) through the Alabama Virtual Library (AVL)
- Remote access of AVL available from WCC home page

### ***Reference Services***

- Available primarily for students, faculty, and staff of WCC
- Available to community patrons as long as it does not interfere with College activities
- Staff assistance during LRC hours
- Online reference assistance available during LRC hours through the LRC home page
- Print format reference materials available for LRC in-house use only

### ***Reserve Materials***

- Located near the circulation desk at each location
- Have limited check-out requirements

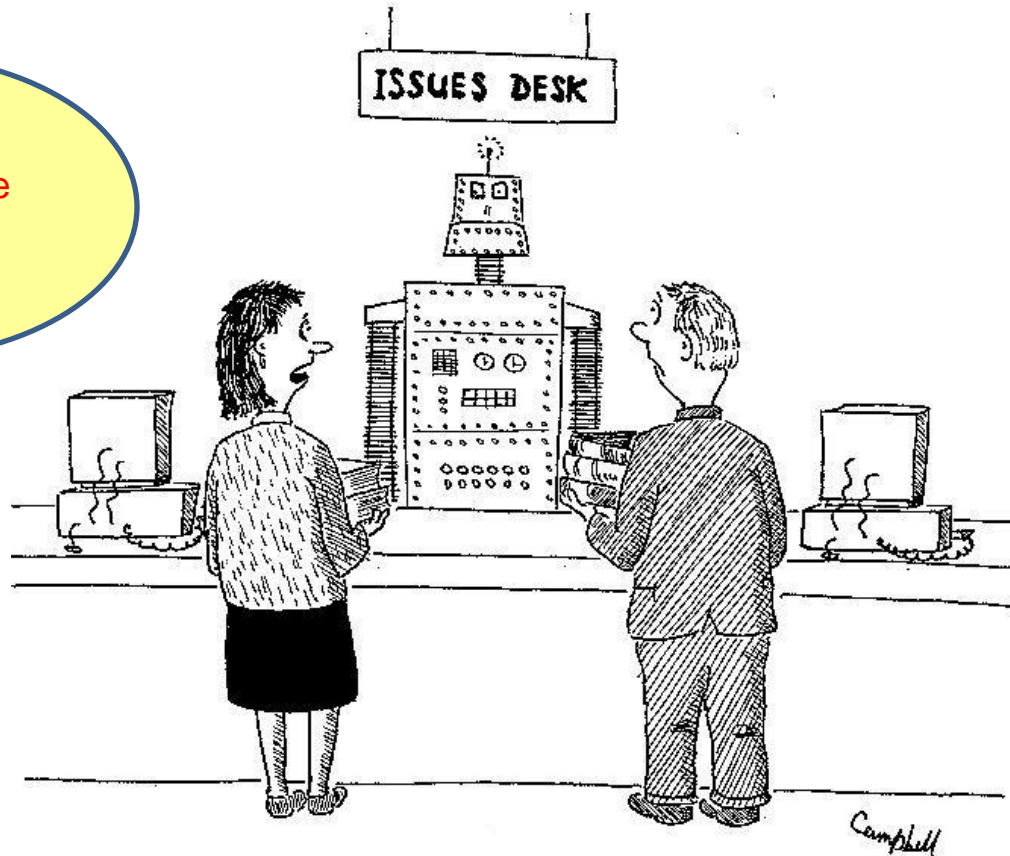
