

WALLACE COMMUNITY COLLEGE SPARKS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

The WCC Sparks Foundation offers a limited number of scholarships for new and currently enrolled students. Listed below are the individual scholarships available, the duration of each award, and the special requirements for obtaining and maintaining each scholarship.

DR. CHARLES O'NEAL APLIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship will pay up to \$500 for tuition, fees, and/or books to a student from Barbour County majoring in an Academic Transfer program, with a preference given to a student majoring in Education.

GET THE TASSEL SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship is given by the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Board to support the Get the Tassel initiative. One scholarship of up to \$500 will be awarded for tuition, fees, and/or books to a student who is completing the last semester of their program of study with less than 12 credit hours. Recipient must have completed the graduation application and demonstrate financial need.

HUMMINBIRD SCHOLARSHIP - Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in Applied Engineering Technology and/or Computer Information Science.

SHANE AND ANNA SEABORN SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship will pay up to \$500 for tuition, fees, and/or books to a student majoring in an Academic Transfer, Health Sciences, or Career Technical program.

SPARKS CAMPUS PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP - A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting the scholarship criteria.

SPARKS CIRCLE AND FLAME SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship will pay up to \$750 for tuition, fees, and/or books to a student meeting the scholarship criteria.
