WALLACE COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

The WCC Foundation offers a limited number of scholarships for new and currently enrolled students. Listed below are the individual scholarships available, the duration of each award, and the special requirements for obtaining and maintaining each scholarship.

CONSTRUCTION PARTNERS, INC. SCHOLARSHIP - The Construction Partners, Inc. Scholarship was established in 2015 to provide students an opportunity to continue their education. **Two** scholarships, each worth \$750, will pay for tuition, fees, and/or books for new or existing WCC students majoring in academic transfer or health sciences. The scholarship will be awarded based on grade point average, unmet financial need, and recommendation from the scholarship committee. This scholarship is non-renewable.

GET THE TASSEL SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship is given by the WCC Foundation Board to support the Get the Tassel initiative. One scholarship of up to \$500 will be awarded for tuition, fees, and/or books to a student who is completing the last semester of their program of study. Recipient must complete the graduation application in Admissions and demonstrate financial need.

MERNA GRIFFIN NURSING SCHOLARSHIP (PILOT CLUB) - The Merna Griffin Nursing Scholarship (Pilot Club) was established in 2015. This scholarship will be awarded each spring semester. The scholarship will pay up to \$750 for tuition, fees, and/or books. The scholarship will be awarded to a student majoring in nursing. This scholarship is renewable.

MADELINE NESSI-SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - The Madeline Nessi-Smith Memorial Scholarship was established in 2003 for students in the Physical Therapy Assistant program. This scholarship, worth \$680, will pay for tuition, fees, and/or books to a WCC student in the PTA Program. The recipient must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher and must be a second-year student entering the last semester of the program. This scholarship is non-renewable.

SERVISFIRST BANK SCHOLARSHIP - The ServisFirst Bank Scholarship was established in 2012 to provide students an opportunity to continue their education. **Two** scholarships, each worth \$1,000, will pay for tuition, fees, and/or books for new or existing WCC students majoring in academic transfer or health sciences. The scholarship will be awarded based on grade point average, unmet financial need, and recommendation from the scholarship committee. This scholarship is non-renewable.

SUNSOUTH BANK SINGLE MOTHER EDUCATION FUND - The SunSouth Bank Single Mother Education Fund was created to provide educational assistance for two (2) female single parents for spring term. This assistance will support tuition, fees, and/or books for up to \$750 for each recipient. This scholarship is non-renewable.

WALLACE COMMUNITY COLLEGE TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP - A scholarship in the amount of \$400 will be awarded to cover the purchase of required technology equipment to complete a student's program of study. The scholarship will be awarded to a Wallace Community College (WCC) Wallace Campus student majoring in any program leading to an associate's degree, with preference given to a first generation student. Successful applicant will submit a completed application package to include transcripts, short essay, and references.

WALLACE SPIRIT OF COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship is provided by the Wallace Community College Foundation. Forty scholarships will be awarded. Scholarship pays up to \$750 for tuition, fees, and/or books for the spring semester. This scholarship is non-renewable.

WCC EMPLOYEE SPIRIT OF GIVING SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship is given by the WCC Foundation Board to honor the financial commitment of faculty and staff to the Foundation. One scholarship up to \$750 will be awarded to a new or returning student who demonstrates financial need. This scholarship is non-renewable.

BILLY, SUZANNE AND LILY WOODS SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship is sponsored by Billy, Suzanne and Lily Woods. Mrs. Suzanne Woods is the CEO of Medical Center Enterprise and a WCC Foundation Board member. This scholarship will pay up to \$750 for tuition, fees, and/or books. This scholarship is non-renewable.
