- The Learning Resources Centers System provides a current collection of resources and services to faculty, staff, and students to support college and lifelong learning.
- The LRC collection includes approximately 40,000 print format books, 150,000 e-books, 100 print periodical titles, and 1,300 audiovisual resources.
- In addition, approximately 60 online electronic databases are available to Wallace Community College students. These databases include the *Alabama Virtual Library*.
- Resources and services are provided at all sites. All students are encouraged to use the LRC resources and services to enhance their learning and research opportunities.




Computers and Information Technologies

What is Geolocation?

Geolocation is the attempt to identify the real-wd object, such as a cell phone or an Internet-connect

The AVL uses this technology to help determine if a at the LRC desk. the user can be authenticated (using geolocation), then to use AVL resources. Otherwise, the user will need to logic username/password.

How does this affect home access?

Using geolocation has made AVL home access much easier. Most users can access AVL resources within the state of Alabama without having to obtain an AVL card.

What about AVL Cards?

Most Alabama users are no longer required to have an AVL card for home access. If users travel or live out of state then they will need an AVL card to access AVL resources. Additionally, users that live near the state line and users who access the Internet via an air card, cell phone, iPad, satellite, or U-verse may not be automatically authenticated; these users will need to log in with their AVL Card.

How does it work?



Campus If you're on the campus of an Alabama public school or library then you'll **Elibrary** see this icon on the right side of the top navigation bar.



If you're recognized as being in the state of Alabama but off campus you'll see this icon on the right side of the top navigation bar.



Please If you're not GeoIP authenticated you'll see this icon on the right side of the top navigation bar.



Simply move your mouse over the icon and type in your username and password on your AVL card. If you enter a valid username and password the icon will change to this.





One of the most helpful databases in the AVL is EBSCO HOST Search. It searches a number of different EBSCO databases simultaneously.


