

The WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Summer 2013 Scholarships

- 1. **Joel P. and Ann Sutton Smith Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County student. The recipient of the scholarship must demonstrate financial need. *(Renewable two terms)*
- 2. **Sparks Foundation Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$500** scholarships will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (*Renewable two terms*)
- 3. **MeadWestvaco Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$583.33** scholarships will be awarded to students who meet the scholarship criteria. (*Renewable for two terms*)
- 4. **Angel Lucas Memorial Drafting Scholarship:** A \$705 scholarship for one term will be awarded to a drafting student.
- 5. **Keystone Foods-Eufaula Division Scholarship:** A **\$833.33** scholarship will be awarded to a dependent of Keystone Foods-Eufaula Division employees. A letter from Keystone Foods must accompany the application. If dependents do not apply, preference will be given to students' enrolled in general business, industrial systems technology, or computer information science. (*Renewable two terms*)
- 6. **Hudson/McGilvary Memorial Scholarship:** A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting the scholarship criteria. The recipient must demonstrate financial need. (*Renewable one term*)
- 7. **Mrs. Christine H. Jaxon Memorial Nursing Scholarship:** A \$695 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County student enrolled in the practical nursing or associate degree nursing program at WCC. The recipient must have no other financial assistance.
- 8. **Gabe Bush Memorial Scholarship:** A **\$631.25** scholarship for two terms. The recipient must demonstrate a financial need.
- Recipient must register for and maintain a full academic load or one that is consistent with the chosen program of study, must have a high school diploma or GED, must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, and meet other specified scholarship criteria.
- <u>Only</u> students enrolled on the Sparks Campus are eligible for scholarships through the Sparks Foundation unless otherwise noted.
- Students must complete the FASFA as part of the application process.

- A short essay, approximately one page, outlining career plans
- Evidence of admission to Wallace Community College (new enrollments only)
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
