

The WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Fall 2013 Scholarships

All scholarships cover tuition, fees, and books. Scholarships are renewable for additional terms if minimum GPA and other criteria are met.

- 1. **Bush/Willis Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$500** scholarships will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (Renewable two terms)
- 2. **Mary C. and Robert M. Dixon Sr. Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (Renewable two terms)
- 3. **L.Y. Dean Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (Renewable one term)
- 4. **Eufaula/Barbour Co. Chamber Existing Industries Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$833.33** scholarships will be awarded to an Alabama resident enrolled in one of the following programs: Drafting and Design Technology, Welding Technology, Industrial Systems Technology, Business and Office Information Processing Concentrations, or Computer Information Science Concentrations. The applicant must demonstrate a financial need. (Renewable for two terms)
- 5. **The James White Memorial Scholarship**: This scholarship was established in 2009 in memory of Mr. White, owner of White and Sons Funeral Home. Mr. White served residents of Barbour County and the surrounding area for more than 40 years. A \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County resident enrolling in any allied health program at WCC (Eufaula or Dothan). Preference will be given to a minority student with a minimum 2.75 GPA.
- 6. **James S. Clark Memorial Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship. The recipient must demonstrate financial need. (Renewable for two terms)
- 7. **Johnston/Kirkland Memorial Scholarship**: A **\$500** scholarship for one semester will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria.
- 8. **Joel P. and Ann Sutton Smith Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County student. The recipient of the scholarship must demonstrate financial need. (Renewable two terms)
- All students <u>must be</u> full-time (12 semester hours), must have a high school diploma or GED, must maintain at least a 2.50 GPA, and meet other specified scholarship criteria.
- <u>Only</u> students enrolled on the Sparks Campus are eligible for scholarships through the Sparks Foundation unless otherwise noted.
