

Scholarships available Spring 2014 through the Sparks Foundation:

All scholarships cover tuition, fees, and books. Scholarships are renewable for additional terms if minimum GPA and other criteria are met.

- 1. Elton B. Stephens, Sales, Sales Management, and Marketing Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in one of the College's business programs. The recipient must be a Barbour County resident. (*Renewable for one term*)
- 2. **Browder and Florence Camp Beasley Memorial Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County resident. (*Renewable for one term*)
- **3. Eufaula/Georgetown Ministerial Association Scholarship:** A scholarship for \$588 will be awarded on the basis of the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Scholarship recommendations to a **single parent** (preferably a woman applicant) who demonstrates a financial need.
- **4. Burt and Elizabeth Smithart Scholarship:** A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour or Bullock County student who demonstrates a financial need. (*Renewable one term*)
- **5. Dempsey and Frances Boyd Scholarship:** A \$650 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County resident. Preference will be given to a student enrolled in the Computer Information Sciences, Office Administration or Accounting programs. The recipient must have no other financial assistance. (Renewable two terms)
- 6. **Eufaula/Barbour Co. Chamber Existing Industries Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$833.33** scholarships will be awarded to an Alabama resident enrolled in one of the following programs: Drafting and Design Technology, Welding Technology, Industrial Maintenance Technology, Business and Office Information Processing Concentrations, or Computer Information Science Concentrations. The applicant must demonstrate a financial need. (*Renewable for two terms*)
- 7. **Humminbird Scholarship:** Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in Industrial Maintenance Technology and/or Computer Information Science.
- 8. Laura Ashley Storey Memorial Nursing Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County resident who has been accepted into the practical nursing or associate degree nursing program at WCC. (Applicant must show proof of acceptance into the program.) The recipient must have no other financial assistance. (Renewable two terms)
- All students <u>must be</u> full-time (12 semester hours), must have a high school diploma or GED, must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, and meet other specified scholarship criteria.
- Only students enrolled on the Sparks Campus are eligible for scholarships through the Sparks Foundation unless otherwise noted.
- Students must complete the FASFA as part of the application process.

- · A short essay, approximately one page, outlining career plans
- Evidence of admission to Wallace Community College (new enrollments only)
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
