

The WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Fall 2014 Scholarships

All scholarships cover tuition, fees, and books. Scholarships are renewable for additional terms if minimum GPA and other criteria are met.

- 1. **Bush/Willis Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$500** scholarships will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (Renewable two terms)
- 2. **Mary C. and Robert M. Dixon Sr. Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (Renewable two terms)
- 3. **L.Y. Dean Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (Renewable one term)
- 4. **James S. Clark Memorial Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship. The recipient must demonstrate financial need. (Renewable for two terms)
- 5. **Johnston/Kirkland Memorial Scholarship**: A **\$500** scholarship for one semester will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria.
- 6. **Joel P. and Ann Sutton Smith Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County student. The recipient of the scholarship must demonstrate financial need. (Renewable two terms)
- 7. **Barefield/Whitehead Memorial Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship for one semester will be awarded to a Sparks Campus student, preferably from Lakeside, Eufaula, or Barbour County High School, majoring in academic transfer, career technical, and/or health sciences.
- 8. **Hudson/McGilvary Memorial Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting the scholarship criteria. The recipient must demonstrate financial need. (Renewable one term)
- 9. **Sparks Foundation Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$500** scholarships will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (Renewable two terms)
- 10. **Charlie Belflower Memorial Scholarship**: A scholarship for \$500 will be awarded on the basis of the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Scholarship recommendations to a <u>single parent</u> (preferably a woman applicant) who demonstrates a financial need. (Renewable one term)
- 11. **MeadWestvaco Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$583.33** scholarships will be awarded to students who meet the scholarship criteria. (Renewable for two terms)
- All students <u>must be</u> full-time (12 semester hours), must have a high school diploma or GED, must maintain at least a 2.50 GPA, and meet other specified scholarship criteria.
- <u>Only</u> students enrolled on the Sparks Campus are eligible for scholarships through the Sparks Foundation unless otherwise noted.

- Evidence of admission to Wallace Community College (new enrollments)
