

Grainger Tools is looking for students who stand out in achievement and leadership and intend to enter the trade or public safety workforce upon graduation. They are offering two \$2000 Grainger Tools for Tomorrow[®] Scholarships to students in certain skilled trade and public safety programs **(see Criteria 1 below)**. One of the two scholarships will be awarded to a U.S. Military Veteran. A Westward toolkit will also be awarded to each recipient upon graduation. These scholarships are open to students on both the Dothan and Sparks campuses.

Criteria:

- Applicant must be enrolled as a full time student (12 credit hours or more) and in their last year of any one of the following Wallace Community College Associate in Applied Science (AAS) programs: Air Conditioning/Refrigeration, Applied Engineering Technology, Automotive Technology, Electrical Technology, Criminal Justice (Law Enforcement Concentration) or Emergency Medical Services – Paramedic.
- 2. Applicant must be eligible to graduate either spring 2016, summer 2016 or fall 2016.
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate GPA of 3.0 or higher with an unofficial transcript.
- 4. Applicant must provide one letter of recommendation from an instructor or advisor.
- 5. Applicant must provide a list of clubs, activities, accomplishments, leadership roles held and years involved, including those relating to their field of study.
- 6. Applicant must provide an essay of 200-300 words on why the student chose to study their selected program, how their achievements and/or leadership roles have helped them grow individually and their future goals within the skilled trades or public safety fields.
- Applicant applying for the Veteran scholarship must provide a copy of the Veteran's DD 214 Member 4 to prove honorable discharge. Veterans who are honorably separated from the U.S. Armed Forces may include their Military Occupational Specialty, Rating, Air Force Specialty Code or military job experience.
