

WCC Sparks Campus Foundation 2016 Summer Scholarships

- 1. Barefield/Whitehead Memorial Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship for one semester will be awarded to a Sparks Campus student, preferably from Lakeside, Eufaula, or Barbour County High School, majoring in academic transfer, career technical, and/or health sciences.
- **2. Charlie Belflower Memorial Scholarship**: A scholarship for \$500 will be awarded on the basis of the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Scholarship recommendations to a **single parent** (preferably a woman applicant) who demonstrates a financial need.
- **3. Dempsey and Frances Boyd Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County resident. Preference will be given to a student enrolled in the Computer Information Sciences, Office Administration or Accounting programs. *The recipient must have no other financial assistance*.
- **4. Gabe Bush Memorial Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting the scholarship criteria. The recipient must demonstrate a financial need.
- **5. Hudson/McGilvary Memorial Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting the scholarship criteria. The recipient must demonstrate financial need.
- **6. Humminbird Scholarship:** A **\$1,000** scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in Applied Engineering Technology and/or Computer Information Science.
- **7. Johnston/Kirkland Memorial Scholarship**: A \$500 scholarship for one semester will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria.
- **8. Keystone Foods-Eufaula Division Scholarship:** An \$833.33 scholarship will be awarded to a dependent of Keystone Foods-Eufaula Division employees. A letter from Keystone Foods must accompany the application. If dependents do not apply, preference will be given to students' enrolled in general business, applied engineering technology, or computer information science.
- **9. WestRock Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$583.33** scholarships will be awarded to students who meet the scholarship criteria.
- **10. Summer 2016 General Scholarship:** Five (5) \$750 scholarships will be awarded to students who meet the scholarship criteria.
- **11. Get the Tassel Scholarship:** This scholarship is given by the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Board to support the Get the Tassel initiative. One scholarship of up to \$500 will be awarded for tuition, fees, and/or books to a student who is completing the last semester of their program of study with less than 12 credit hours. Recipient must have completed the graduation application in Admissions and demonstrate financial need.
- Recipient <u>must</u> register for and maintain a full academic load (12 semester hours) or one that is consistent with the chosen program of study, <u>must</u> have a high school diploma or GED, <u>must</u> maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, and meet other specified scholarship criteria.
- Only students enrolled on the Sparks Campus are eligible for scholarships through the Sparks Foundation unless otherwise noted.
- Students must complete the FASFA as part of the application process.

- Scholarship Application Form
- Unofficial High School or College Transcript (must request copy—cannot be obtained from student file)
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (not from family member)
- A short essay, approximately one page, outlining career plans
- Evidence of admission to Wallace Community College (new enrollments only)
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
