THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The University of Alabama is offering one Presidential Scholarship to a student desiring to transfer to their university during the 2016-2017 academic year.

This Presidential Scholarship covers the cost of in-state tuition for four semesters, provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA. To receive the scholarship, the student must have earned an associate's degree from Wallace Community College and maintained at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average. The student must be on-track to graduate by the end of spring semester 2016. The value of the Presidential Scholarship will adjust as the cost of tuition increases. The current value of this scholarship is \$20,340 over four semesters.

One student will be nominated for this scholarship by the appropriate Wallace Community College official or committee.
