

WCC Sparks Campus Foundation 2016 Fall Scholarships

Charlie Belflower Memorial Scholarship: A scholarship for \$500 will be awarded on the basis of the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Scholarship recommendations to a <u>single parent</u> (preferably a woman applicant) who demonstrates a financial need. (*Renewable spring term*)

Lenoree and Robert H. Bennett, Sr. Memorial/FEB Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour County** student. (Preferably western Barbour County) The recipient must demonstrate financial need. (*Renewable spring and summer terms*)

Dempsey and Frances Boyd Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour County** resident. Preference will be given to a student enrolled in the Computer Information Sciences, Office Administration or Accounting programs. The recipient must have no other financial assistance. (Renewable spring term)

Browder and Florence Camp Beasley Memorial Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour County** resident. (*Renewable spring term*)

Bush/Willis Scholarship: Two (2) **\$500** scholarships will be awarded to students meeting scholarship criteria. (*Renewable spring and summer terms*)

James S. Clark Memorial Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a recipient who demonstrates a financial need. (*Renewable spring and summer terms*)

L. Y. Dean Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (Renewable spring term)

Mary C. and Robert M. Dixon Sr. Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (*Renewable spring and summer terms*)

Keystone Foods-Eufaula Division Scholarship: Two \$833.33 scholarships will be awarded to a dependent of Keystone Foods-Eufaula Division employees. A letter from Keystone Foods must accompany the application. If dependents do not apply, preference will be given to students' enrolled in general business, industrial systems technology, or computer information science. (*Renewable spring and summer terms*)

WestRock Scholarship: Two (2) \$583.33 scholarships will be awarded to students who meet the scholarship criteria. (*Renewable spring and summer terms*)

Eufaula/Barbour County Chamber Scholarship: Two (2) **\$833.33** scholarships will be awarded to an Alabama resident enrolled in one of the following programs: Engineering Graphics and Animation, Welding Technology, Applied Engineering Technology, Business and Office Information Processing Concentrations, or Computer Information Science Concentrations. The applicant must demonstrate a financial need. (*Renewable for two terms*)

Sparks Foundation Scholarship: Two (2) **\$500** scholarships will be awarded to students meeting scholarship criteria. (*Renewable spring and summer terms*)

Elton B. Stephens, Sales, Sales Management, and Marketing Scholarship (EBSCO): A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in one of the College's business programs. The recipient must be a Barbour County resident. (Renewable spring term)

Laura Ashley Storey Memorial Nursing Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Barbour County resident who has been accepted into the practical nursing or associate degree nursing program at WCC. (Applicant must show proof of acceptance into the program.) The recipient must have no other financial assistance. (Renewable spring and summer terms)

Joel P. and Ann Sutton Smith Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour County** student. The recipient of the scholarship must demonstrate financial need. (*Renewable spring term*)

Burt and Elizabeth Smithart Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a **Barbour or Bullock County** student who demonstrates a financial need. (*Renewable spring term*)

WCC Sparks Campus Directors' Scholarship: A \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting scholarship criteria. (*Renewable spring term*)

Miranda Brookins Watson Memorial Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student who meets the scholarship requirements. Preference will be given to a student majoring in the child development program.

Eufaula Physical Therapy Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student who meets the scholarship requirements. Preference will be given to a student majoring in the Physical Therapist Assistant program.

Get the Tassel Scholarship: This scholarship is given by the WCC Sparks Campus Foundation Board to support the Get the Tassel initiative. One scholarship of up to \$500 will be awarded for tuition, fees, and/or books to a student who is completing the last semester of their program of study with less than 12 credit hours. Recipient must have completed the graduation application in Admissions and demonstrate financial need.
