#### 2013 Performing Arts Scholarship Day

*Performing Arts Scholarship Day* is an opportunity for students to compete for renewable scholarships in Performing Arts. **Students must apply and be accepted to the College prior to their audition.** 

#### **Application Procedure**

In order to apply for a Performing Arts scholarship at Wallace Community College, it is necessary to complete and bring complete packet to audition day, March 8, 2013:

### 1. Application Packet

- a. Complete Audition Reservation Form (completed online)
- b. Completed Performing Arts scholarship application
- c. Completed Wallace Community College scholarship application form
- d. Attach headshot to the checklist page
- e. Three letters of recommendation from people who are familiar with your abilities in performance
- f. Completed FASFA form
  - i. Financial Aid Application (FAFSA Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
    - 1. <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u> Once completed, attach final printed copy with your application packet.
    - 2. List Wallace Community College as your college of choice. The college code is 001018.
- g. An official high school transcript or GED certificate
- h. Application for Admission to the college

#### 2. Audition Process

- a. Theatre
  - i. Prepare two contrasting monologues, each monologue 90 seconds or less.
  - ii. For more information, contact Savannah Granberry at (334)983-3521, ext. 2314 or <u>sgranberry@wallace.edu</u>.
  - iii. For technical or stage management, be prepared for Interview based on your technical design or stage management skills. If applicable, bring a portfolio or samples which include renderings, models, photographs of works completed.
- b. Music
  - i. Show Choir/Chorus:
    - 1. Round 1 Singers will prepare a 45 second a cappella piece of their choosing.
    - 2. Round 2 Choral rehearsal. Music will be provided.
  - ii. Pianists are expected to play two contrasting pieces from memory.
    - 1. The Elizabeth S. Cunningham scholarship requires proof of minimal financial need; thus it is imperative that each student fill out the FAFSA prior to his/her audition.
  - iii. Instrumentalists or guitarists should play two pieces or etudes in contrasting styles.

#### **Qualification for and Maintenance of Scholarships**

Performing Arts Scholarships will be renewed based on the following criteria:

- 1. The student will maintain at least a cumulative 2.5 grade point average while enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits each semester.
- 2. The student will maintain an exemplary record of rehearsal attendance and will demonstrate leadership in the department.
- 3. The student will demonstrate good campus citizenship.
- 4. The student will satisfactorily participate in activities of their respective department while receiving the scholarship.
