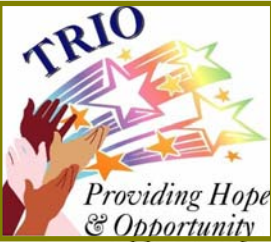
TRiO Participants Attend Financial Literacy Workshop
