TRiO Upward Bound Students View Hidden Figures



On a cold January Saturday a bus load of Sparks Campus Upward Bound students and their chaperones enjoyed a showing of *Hidden Figures* at the Dothan Carmike Theatre. *Hidden Figures* is the account of three African American women who contributed to the U. S. space race: Katherine Johnson (Taraji P. Henson), a "human computer" in the days before digital computers, Dorothy Vaughn (Octavia Spencer), a programmer at the dawn of the computer age, and Mary Jackson (Janelle Monae), one of the first African American women to become an engineer. One of the first uses of digital computers at NASA was to calculate John Glenn's orbit for his historic

flight around the earth. Glenn refused to fly until the figures were checked by Katherine Johnson. These women led the way for the inclusion of women and African Americans in mathematics, computer science, and engineering.

Scholarships and Financial Aid Information

University of Alabama Presidential Scholarship. The University of Alabama is offering one Presidential Scholarship to a student desiring to transfer to their university from Wallace Community College for the 2017-2018 academic year. Deadline to apply is 12 noon on Friday, February 10, 2017.

Wallace Community College Scholarships. Wallace Community College (WCC) offers scholarships in four areas: academic, career technical, performing arts, and health sciences. A student may apply for more than one scholarship. A separate, completed scholarship application packet must be submitted for each scholarship for which a student applies. Only one WCC application for admission is required per student. Deadline to apply is 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 1, 2017 to be eligible for financial aid beginning in August 2017.
