The Financial Aid Office has received information about the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation's 2021 Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship.

The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation will award Undergraduate Transfer Scholarships to outstanding community college students transferring to selective four-year colleges or universities in **fall 2021**. Each scholarship will cover a significant share of the student's educational expenses including tuition, living expenses, books, and other required fees for the final two to three years of a bachelor's degree.

To qualify for the scholarship program, a candidate must, at a minimum, meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a current student at an accredited U.S. community college or two-year institution with sophomore status by January 1, 2021, or be a recent graduate (since spring 2016);
- Plan to enroll full-time in a baccalaureate program at an accredited college or university in **fall** 2021:
- Have a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent);
- Demonstrate unmet financial need;
- No previous attendance at a four-year institution.

The application for the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship is now available. In order to apply, applicants must submit an electronic application through the **Common App for Transfer**, accessible via the Foundation's website at jkcf.org/transfer, by **Wednesday**, **January 6**, **2021 at 11:59 p.m. CST**.
