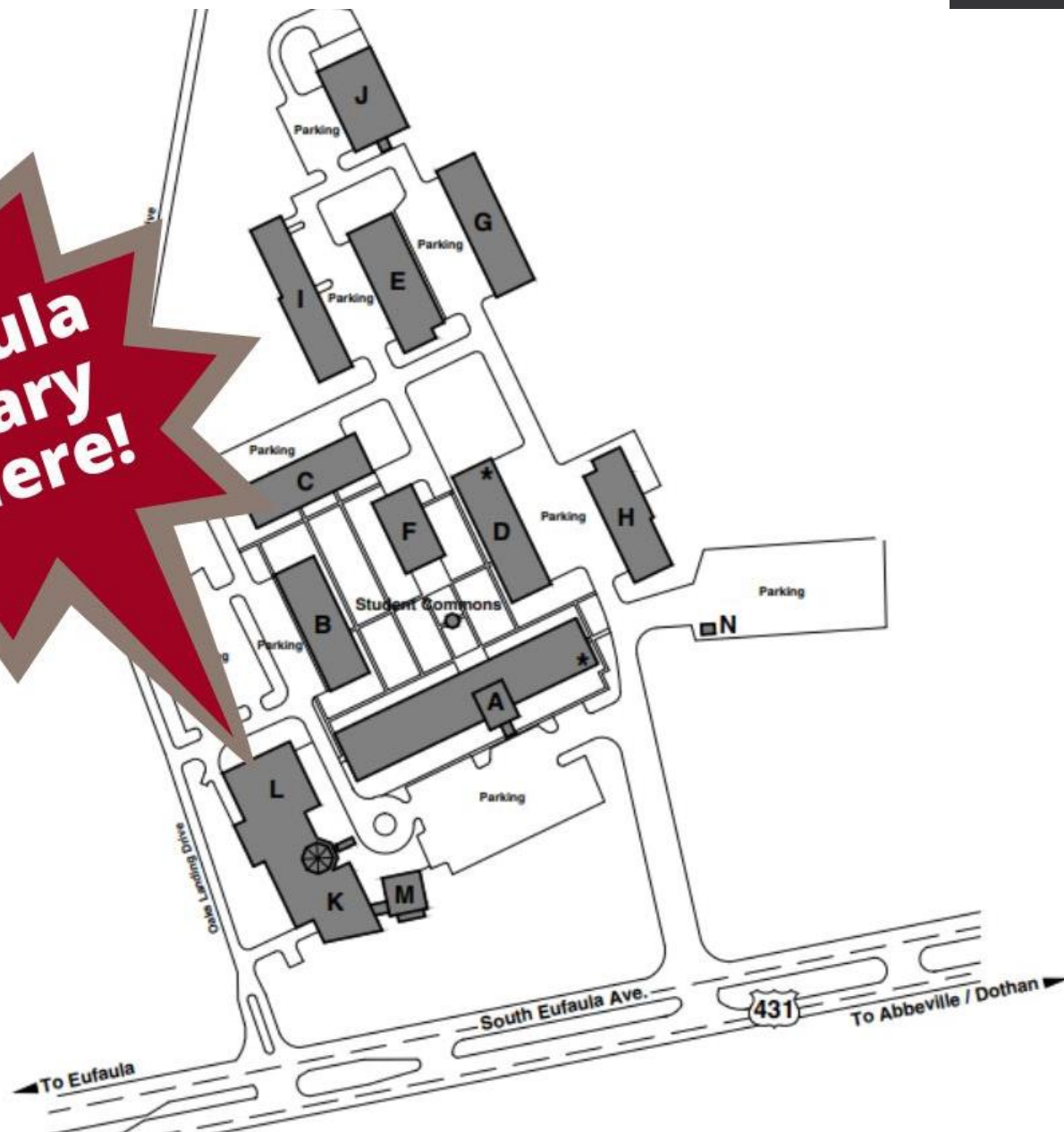

# Wallace Community College Learning Resources Centers System

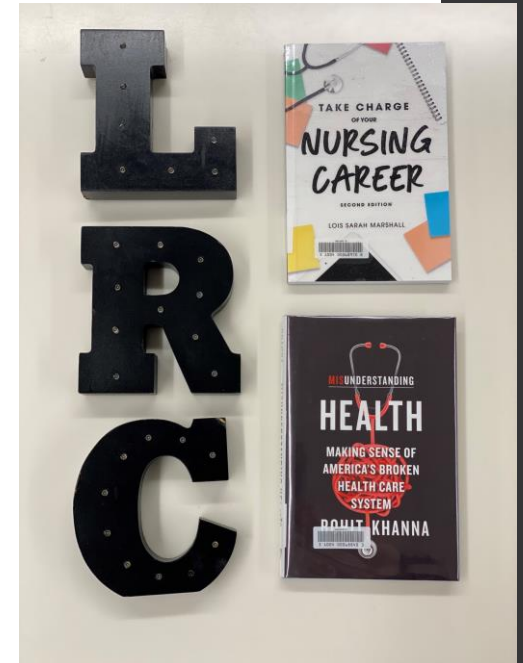


- The Learning Resources Centers (LRC) System provides a current collection of materials and services to faculty, staff, and students to support college and lifelong learning.
- Resources and services are provided at all sites. All students are encouraged to use the materials and services to enhance their learning and research opportunities.

# Available Resources and Services



- ***Circulating Print Book Collection***
  - Includes approximately 27,000 print format books
  - Available for check-out for up to four weeks by students.
- ***Reserve Materials***
  - Located near the circulation desk at each location
- ***Wallace College E-Book Collection***
  - Access to over 150,000 e-books
  - Access from on-campus and off-campus locations
  - Accessible from the Wallace College LRC home page
- ***Media Software Collection***
  - Includes approximately 2,400 audiovisual items
  - Available for 7-day check-out
