The Financial Aid Office has received information about the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation's Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship.

The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation will award Undergraduate Transfer Scholarships to outstanding community college students who plan to enroll full-time in a baccalaureate program at an accredited college or university in **fall 2024**. Each scholarship will cover a significant share of the student's educational expenses for the final two to three years of a bachelor's degree, including tuition, living expenses, books and required fees.

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship program, a candidate must, at a minimum, meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a current student at an accredited U.S. community college or two-year institution with sophomore status by January 1, 2024, **or** be a recent graduate (since spring 2019)
- Plan to enroll full-time in a baccalaureate program at an accredited college or university in **fall of 2024**
- Possess a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 3.5 or better on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent)
- Demonstrate unmet financial need
- No previous enrollment or attendance at a four-year institution

The application for the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation's Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship is now available. To apply, students must submit an electronic application through the **Common App for**

**Transfer**, which can be accessed via the Foundation's website at [www.jkcf.org/transfer](http://www.jkcf.org/transfer), by **Thursday, January 11, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. CST**.
