2023-2024 The Ford Fund STEM Scholarship Program

The Ford Fund STEM Scholarship is for candidates, who are undergraduate students of color enrolled in STEM-related degree programs at accredited U.S. colleges and universities or two (2)year colleges during the 2023-24 academic year.

Eligibility Criteria:

Possess a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5

File a FAFSA Form (Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form)

Demonstrate unmet financial need as verified by the college or university

Be a U. S. Citizen, National, or Permanent Resident of the United States

Be a student of color

Be a full time college junior or senior attending a four-year accredited

attending a four-year accredited institution or a full time student attending a two year accredited institution or certification (certificate) program

Eligible majors include:

 Electrical, Mechanical, Chemical, Manufacturing, Industrial, Software, or Environmental

Industrial, Software, or Environmental Engineering.

 Engineering Studies: Process, Quality, Computer,

Systems, Battery, Automation Controls, Safety, Materials.

Cyber-Security.

software expertise relevant to Automotive Industry:
