Thank you for continuing to prepare your students for collegiate success. I am pleased to share some of the ways in which UAB continues to be a first choice for your students' educational goals, as well as some of the exciting initiatives taking place across campus:

- In fall 2021 UAB maintained its momentum in growing enrollment with diverse and talented students, exceeding 22,000 total enrollment for a third consecutive year—including a freshman class that was our largest (2,415) and most diverse ever at 65 percent female, 45 percent underrepresented, and 28 percent first-generation.
- UAB continues to offer unrivaled academic, research, and service opportunities to our undergraduates, who in spring 2022 earned—among other national and international honors—three Goldwater Scholarships and five Fulbright Awards for research and service in France, Spain, Czech Republic, Taiwan and Germany.
- We are building state-of-the-art new academic and research buildings, such as our Science and Engineering Complex scheduled to open in spring 2023.
- Our **newly created Transfer Advisor position** in Undergraduate Admissions is providing invaluable pre-enrollment advising, support and resources to our prospective community college students.
